Chief Editor's message

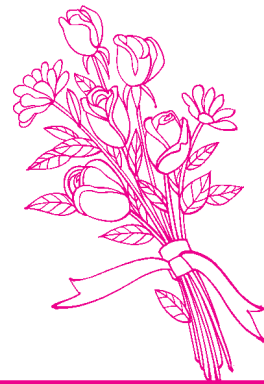

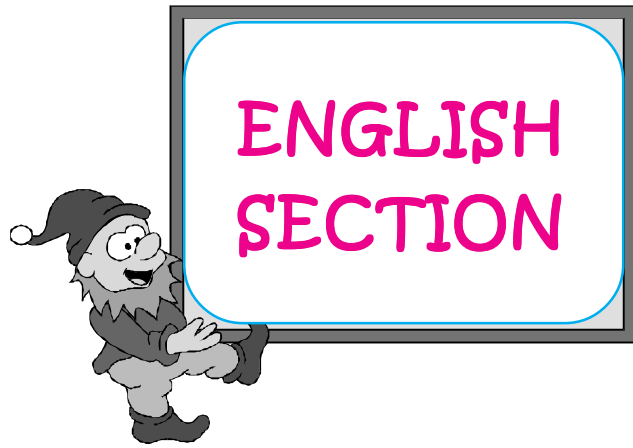
On behalf of the magazine team I thank everybody who contributed. I hope that the Vidyalaya Patrika 2019-20 is entertaining and readable.

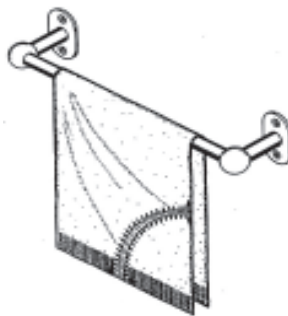
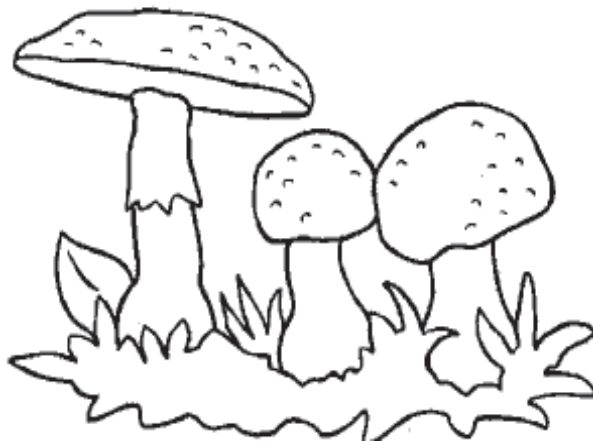

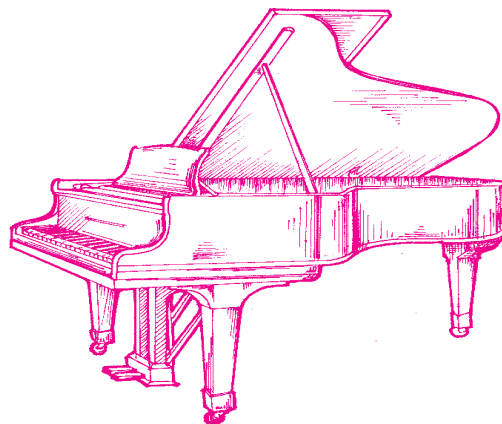

MARIANA TRENCH

While thousands of climbers have successfully scaled Mount Everest, the highest point on earth, only two people have descended to the planet's deepest point, the Challenger Deep in the Pacific Ocean's Mariana Trench.

Located in the western Pacific east of the Philippines and an average of approximately 124 miles (200 kilometers) east of the Mariana Islands, the Mariana Trench is a crescent-shaped scar in the Earth's crust that measures more than 1500 miles (2550 kilometers) long and 43 miles (69 kilometers) wide on average. The distance between the surface of the ocean and the trench's deepest point, the Challenger Deep, which lies about 200 miles (322 kilometers) southwest of the U.S. territory of Guam – is nearly 7 miles (11 kilometers). If Mount Everest were dropped into the Mariana Trench, its peak would still be more than a mile (1.6 kilometers) underwater.

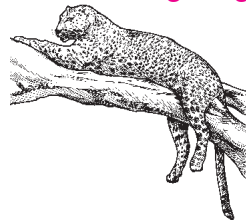

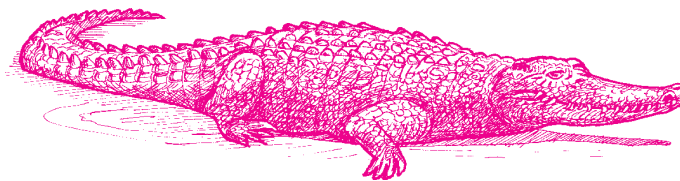

NOISE POLLUTION – A HARMFUL MENACE

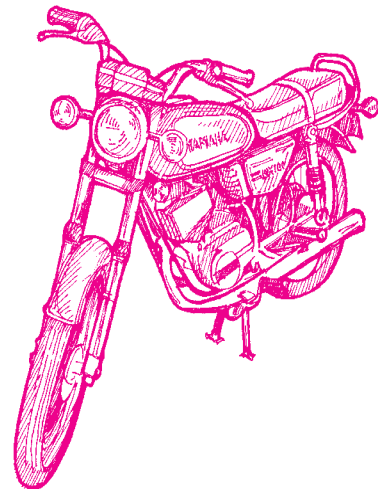

- ** Follow the Limits of noise.

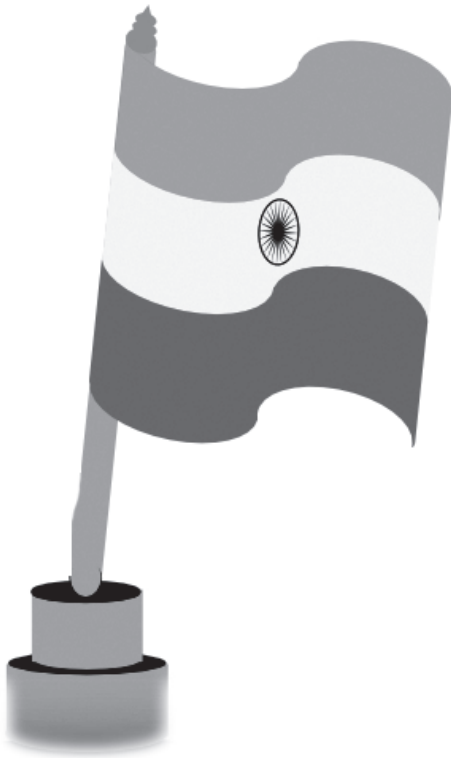

OUR NATIONAL FLAG



The Indian National Flag is the symbol of the land and people of India. Our National flag is a tricolor panel made up of three rectangular panes or sub-panel of equal widths. The colour of the top panel is India saffron (Kesaria) and that of the bottom is Indian green. The middle panel is white, bearing at its centre the design of the Ashoka Chakra in Navy blue colour with 24 equally spaced spokes. The flag is rectangular in shape with the ratio of the length to the height (width) brings 3.2. The Ashoka chakra is visible on both sides of the flag in the centre of the white panel. Dr.S.Radhakrishna explained about the National flag in the constituent Assembly which adopted it, “Bhagwa or the saffron colour denotes renunciation or disinterestedness. The white in the centre is light, the path of truth to guide our conduct. The green shows our relation to the soil, our relation to the plant life here on which all other life depend.

Smart phones and other devices used around bed time reduce sleep time.

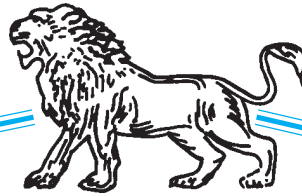

गांधीजी हमारे राष्ट्र के पिता हैं। उनका पूरा नाम मोहनदास करमचंद गांधी है। रवींद्रनाथ टैगोर ने उन्हें 'महात्मा' की उपाधि दी थी। इसका अर्थ है 'एक महान आत्मा'। हम उसे "बापू" भी कहते हैं। गांधीजी का जन्म 2 अक्टूबर, 1869 को गुजरात राज्य के पोरबंदर में हुआ था। मैट्रिक पास करने के बाद उन्होंने इंग्लैंड जाकर लॉ की पढ़ाई की। वह 1891 में बैरिस्टर बन गया।



1893 में गांधीजी एक कानूनी मामले पर दक्षिण अफ्रीका गए। उस समय अफ्रीकी सरकार का इस्तेमाल वहां रहने वाले भारतीयों के साथ बुरा बर्ताव करने के लिए किया जाता था। गांधीजी भारतीयों के कष्टों से बहुत प्रभावित हुए। उन्होंने भारतीयों की रहने की स्थिति में सुधार के लिए सरकार के खिलाफ शांतिपूर्ण लड़ाई का नेतृत्व किया। वह दक्षिण अफ्रीका में हमारे लोगों को कई अधिकार दिलाने में सफल रहा।

वह भारत लौट आए और स्वतंत्रता संग्राम में शामिल हो गए। वह ने अहिंसक आंदोलन का नेतृत्व किया। अहिंसा और सत्याग्रह अंग्रेजी शासन के खिलाफ लड़ने के लिए दो महान हथियार थे। उन्होंने कई अहिंसक आंदोलन, 'स्वदेशी' और 'भारत छोड़ो' आंदोलन का नेतृत्व किया। उनके नेतृत्व में भारत 15 अगस्त, 1947 को आजाद हुआ।

गांधीजी को सत्य पर बहुत विश्वास था। 'अहिंसा' और ईश्वर। उन्होंने हरिजनों के उत्थान, और अस्पृश्यता को दूर करने के लिए काम किया। उन्होंने हिंदू मुस्लिम एकता के लिए कड़ी मेहनत की। 30 जनवरी, 1948 को उनकी गोली मारकर हत्या कर दी गई थी। लेकिन उनका संदेश हमारे राष्ट्र को हमेशा के लिए निर्देशित करता है।

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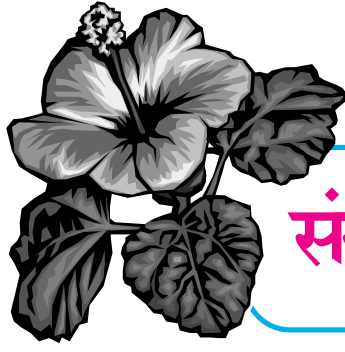
